## Rules on Disqualification of Parliamentarians of Asgardia

- 1. The Parliamentarians shall be accountable to the Asgardian citizens (or residents prior to the formal establishment of citizenship).
- 2. A group of no less than 15 Parliamentarians may submit a written request to the Chair of the Parliament for the disqualification of a Parliamentarian. In a demand for the disqualification of a Parliamentarian, the reasons for the disqualification shall be clearly stated. The Chair of Parliament and The Head of Administration to the Head of Nation may also initiate disqualification procedures.
- 3. The Chair of the Parliament shall communicate with the Parliamentarian who is subject to the potential disqualification, who shall have the right to present a written statement in his own defence within 15 days.
- 4. The Chair of the Parliament shall submit the file and proposed decision to the Supreme Space Council for consideration and endorsement in the following cases.
- a) The Parliamentarian loses Asgardian citizenship/residency;
- b) The Parliamentarian fails to participate in at least two consecutive Parliament sittings (including electronic and physical sittings) without proper justifications;
- c) The Parliamentarian has taken actions that are in violation with the Supreme Values of Asgardia (defined in Chapter 2, Article 2 of the Constitution), of the Asgardian Constitution and other laws;
- d) The Parliamentarian has committed a misconduct that negatively affects the publicity of the nation, or contributed to any other situations that make the Parliamentarian inappropriate to continue in his position.
- 5. After the decision is taken by the Supreme Space Council on the basis of the presentation of the Parliament Chair, it is forwarded to Court for the final ruling. The decision of Asgardian Court is final.
