



PROTOCOL NO. 2

Of the session of the Counting Commission

Following the review of election results to the first Parliament of Asgardia

29 MARCH 2018 (4 APRIL 0002)

Members of the Counting Commission were presented with logfiles (the files that contain all the relevant data to verify votes, e.g. IP-addresses) of the final voting period for the parliamentary elections of Asgardia, which took place during the period of 1-9 March 2018 (4-12 March 0002), in accordance with Decree No. 14 by the Head of Nation.

A review of gross violations such as vote falsification has been conducted to ensure that no candidates used illegal technological manipulations for increasing the number of votes they received and/or directly or indirectly acted in violation of the Constitution of Asgardia.

The logfiles of 111 candidates have been reviewed. As of the moment, these candidates have met the mandatory conditions in accordance with the Provision of the Central Electoral Commission (CEC) on elections to the first Parliament of Asgardia, and the Announcement of the CEC regarding the closing of the final voting period.

This review included the verification of data in candidate profiles on the basis of their personal identification documents.

As the result of the review, at the moment of the drafting of this protocol in accordance with the Announcement of the CEC regarding the closing of the final voting period, 100 candidate applications have been presented to the CEC for review.
