



RULES

of Holding Election of Mayors of Asgardia

Via conference call; revised 03 June 2026

The Central Electoral Commission of Asgardia Approves the Rules for Holding Election of Mayors of Asgardia.

1. The Rules define the procedure for the nomination of candidates, the preparation, conduct and announcement of the results of elections for the mayors of Asgardia. The elections are organised and conducted by the Central Electoral Commission of Asgardia (hereinafter referred to as the CEC) using Asgardia's digital system.
2. Mayoral election shall be held within Earth cities and towns based on information about the place of residence indicated by Asgardians in the digital profiles.
3. Asgardians who, at the time of voting, hold Asgardian resident status, have reached the age of 18, have accepted the Constitution of Asgardia, and have paid for their residency up to the closing date of the vote, are entitled to vote in the mayoral election.
Voting takes place exclusively at the place of residence specified in the Asgardian resident's digital profile.
4. Any Asgardian resident shall be liable to run for mayor. An Asgardian shall have the right to run for mayor of his or her respective locality in the absence of incumbent mayor.
Asgardian Members of Parliament, Ministers and Justices shall be eligible for running for mayor.
5. In order to stand for election as mayor and to exercise the powers of the mayor, a candidate and the elected mayor must hold valid resident status in Asgardia. In the context of the Asgardian mayoral elections, a candidate or mayor is deemed to meet the requirements of these Regulations provided that their residency is renewed no later than thirty (30) calendar days from the expiry date of their residency.
6. The procedure for electing a mayor may be initiated provided that there are at least five (5) Asgardians in the relevant settlement, including at least three (3) residents of Asgardia.
Residency status is not verified for the purposes of this clause.
A reduction in the number of Asgardians below the specified threshold after the

procedure has commenced shall not affect the conduct of the election.

7. A mayoral candidate shall apply via Asgardian digital system. The candidate's application shall contain information necessary to verify the candidate's identity, a copy of the identification document, a candidate's photo along with the aforesaid document, and an election programme.

Applications are verified by the CEC or by authorised representatives of Asgardia. The CEC is entitled to refuse to register a candidate or to remove a candidate from the election if the documents submitted by the candidate are in conflict with the Constitution of Asgardia.

8. Until the first candidate has been approved, no preparations for the election shall be made and no voting date shall be set. Once the first candidate has been approved, the election preparation phase begins, lasting twenty-eight (28) calendar days, during the first twenty-one (21) of which other candidates are entitled to submit their applications.

9. At the end of the twenty-eight (28) calendar-day pre-election preparation period, the voting stage begins, which lasts for seven (7) calendar days using the Asgardia digital system.

10. The mayor is elected by a simple majority of votes for a term of one (1) calendar year.

The election is deemed to have taken place provided that a candidate has received at least three (3) votes from residents of Asgardia.

If no candidate receives at least three (3) votes, or if candidates receive an equal number of votes, or if no votes are cast, the election is deemed to have failed and is reclassified as 'not initiated'.

The election results are summarised by the CEC.

11. The position of mayor shall be tacitly taken to be vacant on expiry of the mayor's term.

The incumbent mayor shall enjoy the right to apply for new election no later than twenty-eight (28) calendar days before the end of the term; with starting new election, the mayor's position shall not be deemed vacant until culmination of voting.

12. Residents of Asgardia involved in the mayoral election for the relevant locality shall be precluded from mayoral re-voting for the same locality for the mayor-elect competency term.

There shall be no restrictions on voters changing place of residence; however, mayoral re-voting for the relevant locality shall not be allowed.

13. The relevant restrictions shall be subject to cancellation given the election being declared invalid, or the voting results being annulled, or withdrawing the candidate.

The technical procedures for implementing digital voting mechanisms and status tracking are governed by Asgard's internal regulations.

14. The Rules shall come into force on the date of their approval by the Central Electoral Commission of Asgardia.

The previous version of the Rules of Holding Election of Mayors of Asgardia shall apply insofar as it does not conflict with these Rules.
