



## PROTOCOL NO. 3

Of the Session of the Central Electoral Commission (CEC)

On the Results of the Elections to Asgardia's First Parliament

18 MAY 2018 (26 MAY 0002)

The Central Electoral Commission, under the chairmanship of Markus Gronbach, has reviewed the report of the Counting Commission under the chairmanship of Robert Thomas.

Based on the Counting Commission's report, the results of the by-elections voting period to the parliamentary elections of Asgardia have been reviewed:

- The CEC confirms that the verification of the documents of 52 candidates who have met the mandatory conditions in accordance with the Provision of the CEC on elections to the first Parliament of Asgardia is complete. The review of the identification documents of the candidates has been deemed valid.
- No major falsifications or other instances of gross misconducts have been uncovered.
- The CEC will begin the mandatory international criminal background check within 72 hours following the publication of this decree.

If a candidate refuses the background check, and thus removes their candidacy, they must immediately (within 72 hours of the publication of this decree) notify Asgardia by sending a message to [elections@asgardia.space](mailto:elections@asgardia.space) with the subject line "Criminal Background Check".

Individuals who have been refused the position of Member of Parliament, or individuals who have resigned from the position of their own volition, cannot, in public or private arenas, refer to themselves as Member of Parliament, former Member of Parliament, elected Member of Parliament and the like, as the final confirmation of their elected position only takes place after the in-person ID verification; until that point they are not considered as having assumed their Member of Parliament positions in a legal capacity.

Throughout the election, the CEC received several complaints against some candidates for Members of the Parliament, which it had to review and investigate. During that review process, there was no doubt, based upon the evidence provided, that two people had to have their candidacies for the MP positions removed.

In case it is a matter that has to be decided by the Supreme Justice of Asgardia, after the Supreme Justice is nominated, he/she will receive the required materials from the CEC for making a judicial decision.

Also, two candidates decided to exit of their own volition from the preliminary list of the results of the first stage of voting, which took place during the period of 1-9 March 2018 (4-12 March 0002), and one candidate - after the second stage of voting, which took place during the period of 6-16 May 2018 (14-24 May 0002). Consequently, the preliminary list at the time of writing the present protocol comprises 147 persons.

The decision about the final composition of the Parliament will be made by the Parliament itself during its first on-site assembly on 24 June 2018 (7 Asgard 0002), and further ratified by the Head of Nation.

Adherence to the Constitution of Asgardia, for which all Asgardians who exist at the moment have voted, is mandatory for all of the citizens of Asgardia.
