

# THE PARLIAMENT OF ASGARDIA



## RULES

### On Continuation of Elections of Asgardia's Mayors

via conference call

The Central Electoral Commission (CEC) has confirmed the following rules for continuation of the elections of Asgardia's mayors:

1. Mayoral candidates from cities and unions of cities on the planet Earth can submit their candidacies for running in the elections from October 12, 2018 (October 5, 0002) until the Parliament passes the corresponding law. Submissions are accepted on Asgardia's official site, [www.asgardia.space](http://www.asgardia.space).
2. Any resident of Asgardia who has reached the age of 18 can participate in the election. Residents are those who have completed all the mandatory fields of the registration profile on Asgardia's official site, including acceptance of the Constitution.
3. Cities on the planet Earth that have at least 100 Asgardian residents and at least 5000 people are allowed to participate in the elections.
4. To participate in the elections for cities with less than 100 Asgardian residents:
  - Mayoral candidates must run a campaign to increase the number of residents in their cities to the minimally required 100 persons until the Parliament passes the corresponding law, otherwise their candidacy will not be considered.
  - Every resident will be given an opportunity to choose for voting or nomination of themselves any of the nearby cities with the purpose of forming an electoral district.
  - A district is a union of two or more nearby cities of the planet Earth with the residents of Asgardia, with the purpose of reaching the required mark of 100 residents.
5. Cities where mayors have been elected earlier, do not participate in current elections.
6. Prior to the registration each candidate is given an opportunity to select a city that they are nominating for as a mayor.
7. In case if the population of the city is less than 5000 people this city can be united with a nearby city with the population of less than 5000 people.
8. A number of candidates nominated from one city is unlimited.

9. To register as a candidate, it is necessary to fill out a personal profile on the website [www.asgardia.space](http://www.asgardia.space) and publish a short programme and/or a video message to the potential constituents.

10. The Administration of Asgardia retains the right to remove from elections those candidates whose pre-electoral message is contrary to the Constitution of Asgardia.

11. A mandatory condition for a nomination of the candidate is a paid registration fee in the amount of 100 Euros.

12. Voting will take place in the period from October 12, 2018 (October 5, 0002) until the Parliament passes the corresponding law. Every resident can vote for only one candidate in their city or district. In summing up the votes, only direct voting is counted. Resident who participates in the voting is prohibited from giving their vote to another resident or vote on his/her behalf.

13. The final list of elected candidates will be affirmed by the Head of the Nation after the CEC presents its protocol.

14. A mayor's authority includes representing Asgardia in their city (district), the formation of a citywide (districtwide) budget, the verification of citizens in their city (district) as well as other duties in accordance with the law of Asgardia.

15. The term of office of a mayor is set for at least one calendar year with a possibility of subsequent reelection in accordance with the law of Asgardia.
