# PROTOCOL XIV PARLIAMENTARY SITTING OF ASGARDIA 08-10 CAPRICORNUS, 0005 (10–12 DECEMBER 2021)

#### TYPE AND LOCATION

The 14th Parliamentary Sitting of Asgardia was held on 08-10 Capricornus 0005 (10-12 December 2021) in the form of digital presence, using platforms ZOOM, SLACK and the electronic voting system of Asgardia.

#### REGISTRATION AND QUORUM

Registration was carried out on the digital platform of Asgardia.

At the time of the registration, the Parliament constituted **137** members (AMPs), who were authorized to be admitted to registration and voting.

Registration, corresponding to the report of the Mandate Commission 118 parliamentarians (AMPs), was 86%, exceeding the required quorum total of 50% + 1 Asgardian Members of Parliament.

The quorum was achieved.
